Who We Are: Trinity Baptist Weekday Preschool

Trinity Baptist Weekday Preschool (TBWP) is a part-time preschool program designed to provide a nurturing and faith-based environment for young children. Our program operates for three hours each day and offers a four-day program for children who are 1, 2, or 3 years old, and a five-day program for 4-year-olds. Our curriculum emphasizes the importance of loving our neighbors, as taught in the Bible, while also preparing each child for the transition to kindergarten.

Registration Fees and T-Shirts

Registration fees are non-refundable and due at the time of enrollment.

One school T-shirt is included in the price of registration. Additional shirts are available for purchase.

Program Structure and Priorities

Our program is dedicated to demonstrating God’s love to every child. To ensure optimal supervision and meaningful interaction, we maintain smaller student-to-teacher ratios than those recommended by the State of South Carolina. Each class is staffed with two adult teachers, a lead teacher and an assistant, both of whom are required to pass a background check prior to employment.

Curriculum and Daily Activities

Teachers develop lesson plans utilizing the Funshine Express Curriculum, along with a variety of early childhood educational resources. Every class is provided with healthy snacks and water to support children’s well-being throughout the day.

Fostering Positive Behaviors and Skills

During class, teachers reinforce the values you instill at home by encouraging respect, cooperation, kindness, and the use of good manners. Through the partnership between your family and the TBWP staff, each child will:

- Learn about Jesus and his love for everyone.
- Develop the skills necessary for success in kindergarten.
- Gain an understanding of how to treat others, modeled after Jesus’ example.
- Use manners during snack time and playtime.
- Demonstrate appropriate classroom behavior, such as lining up and sitting quietly.
- Engage properly in activities and play, both verbally and physically, with other children.
